JEANNE & DON'S RESTAURANT & DANCE PAVILION, STOKES BAY, ONTARIO

Built by John L. McIver in 1918-19. Operated as store by Charlie and Lizzie (Lang) McDonald -1919-1920. Postoffice also. Malcolm and Florence McIver 1921-22 store & postoffice. Also had an icecream parlour in part later used as dance hall. J. T. Rouse, 1922-25. Malcolm & Jeanne Smith, 1927-1931. Jeanne Florence Smith, 1931-32. Later operated as restaurant and dance hall by Jeanne Smith in partnership with Don Cameron. Since then operated as restuarant by Darlings, and present owner Joe Westward (1981) \*\*\*\*\*

Remembered by many as a dance hall before, during and after World War 11 where the Shouldice Orchestra gave out with Swing and Sway with Harry Oswell at the piano. Now a restaurant only. \*\*\*\*\*
