The name of the Club is Tamarack Island Fishing & Shooting Club and the Club was incorporated under Letters Patent dated June 12th 1913. I am unable to find an original list of membership but the following list of names shows the men who were instrumental in forming the Club.

The George Kirks' were the first stewards and were with the Club until 1927 when the Allan McLays' took over. Mrs McLay passed away about 1955 and Allan McLay and his daughters have been carrying on since that time.
