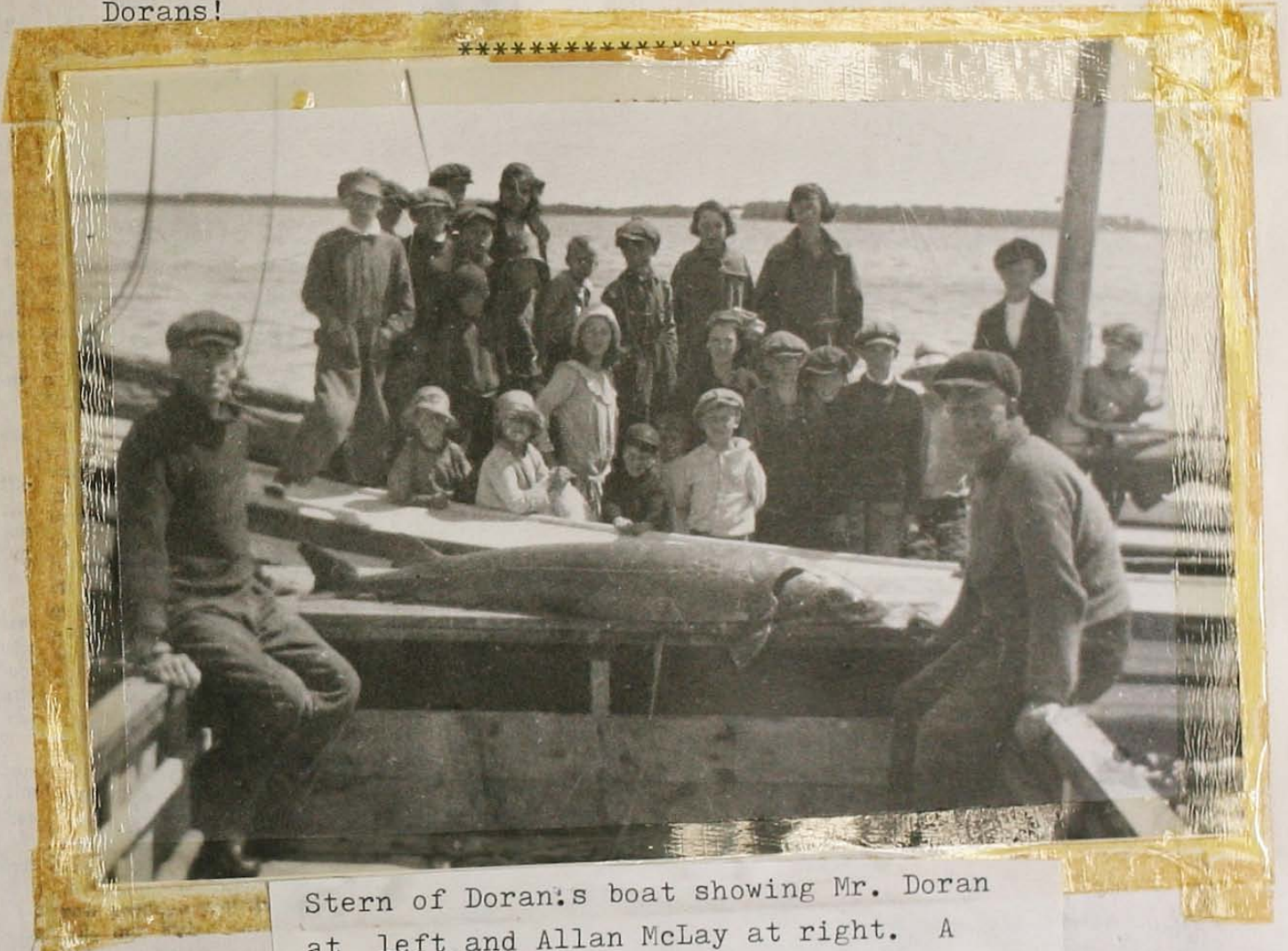


3.....Dorans.
