Joined Canadian Infantry Corp on April 1, 1943 and was immediately posted overseas. Upon landing was transferred to the Perth Regiment. Served in the Italy campaign, France, Belgium, Holland and Germany. He was wounded in Italy and spent eight months in hospital receiving the gold stripe for injury.

Arrived home on New Year's Day at Halifax in 1946. Upon demobilization of the Canadian Army, received discharge Feb. 16, 1946 in Canada.
