Papers on Citizenship were read at open meeting of this branch. Young people were helped and encouraged in anything that made for better citizenship. Moving pictures were shown in our school by our Agriculture Representative on several occasions.

COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES AND PUBLIC RELATIONS

Purchased and convened a lending library. Installed Oil stove, cupboard, and dishes, for serving hot lunches at school. Purchased an organ, also had well dug and pump installed in school grounds. First Aid Kit was purchased for school and is replenished yearly. An annual treat of cake, ice cream, and candy is given to our school children at the close of the school term. Gifts to every new baby, gifts to brides, flowers, fruits, and cards sent to the sick in the community, also flowers sent to the bereaved families in the communitys.

Helped win the two wars being our most serious consideration all members helped by knitting, sewing, making quilts, donated blankets, having social evenings, card parties, and dances, to raise money for war work. Donations of money to British Red Cross Society, Prison of War fund, Belgium relief, Russian relief fund, Sugar fund for Britian, Mobile canteen kitchen, seeds for Britain, \$15.00 towards spitfire, helped Red Cross and Red Shield with sewing, knitting, and money donations during Wars I and II. Also purchased material for bandages and Khaki handkerchiefs. Remembered all our boys overseas with boxes of food, also a girl, and presented all our returned boys and girl with gifts, also a war bride in War I tea to Britain. Other donations were to Sick Children Hospital in Toronto, Tuberculosis Hospital, Cancer research, Home Fire Sufferers, Northern Fire Sufferers, Women's Council, Manitoba Flood Relief, Yearly donations to the blind children's Aid Society, Red Cross, Red Shield, Renfrew Hospital for upkeep of W.I. ward, donations of food to children
