National Convention

After the organization of the F.W.I.C., the Board of Directors' meetings were sometimes held in conjunction with Provincial Conventions. In 1957, to celebrate the 60th Anniversary of the founding of the Women's Institute, the first National Convention was held in Ottawa. Since then, Triennial Conventions have been held in Vancouver, British Columbia in 1961; Wolfville, Nova Scotia, 1964; Guelph, Ontario, 1967; Winnipeg, Manitoba, in 1970; Banff, Alberta, 1973; and in Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island in 1976.
