"This is a local farm mutual insurance company providing financial assistance to the local area, said Leader, "and Trillium has always been generous in doing so."

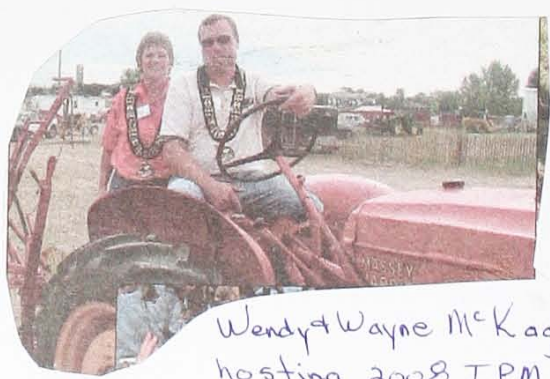
