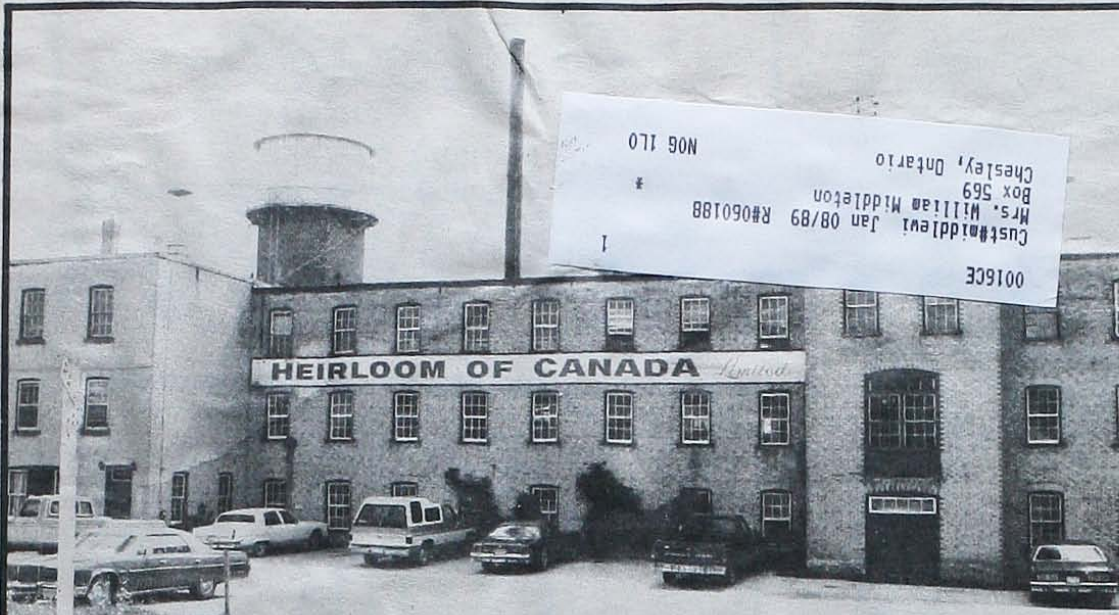
The news was out before even the employees knew it. Effective August 15 Heirloom of Canada Inc. in Chesley is in receivership.
