

Community Hall. Glasgow.

On May 5th 1914. a meeting was held in Davis Hall, to discuss the building of a Public Hall. A. H. Johnston was Chairman, and A. S. Murphy, Secretary.

A Committee was appointed to draft rules for the management of the Hall, consisting of A. S. Murphy, A. H. Johnston, John W. Hamilton, Jessie Murphy and Margaret Affleck.

A building Committee was appointed, namely, J. W. Hamilton, Gordon Affleck, John Carswell, Leo Cherry, and A. S. Murphy, Secy.

A Picnic was planned in aid of the building, charge for meals 25 cts for adults and 15¢ for children under 12 yrs. Charge for hay on picnic grounds, be 20 cts for span of horses, and 10 cts for a single horse. Bertie Stewart to look after the hay. This picnic was held in June. Proceeds amounted to \$97.59 with some bills not yet paid.

Another meeting was held Feb 1st 1915, to consider ways of proceeding with the building. It was decided to canvass for funds, and James Hamilton, Andrew Carswell & John Carswell were provided with subscription lists.

On June 28. 1915 the building Committee met in the New Hall. Trustees were John Carswell, A. S. Murphy and James Hamilton.

First Annual Meeting was held on Dec 28. 1916. Building of horse sheds was discussed. The kitchen was built
