

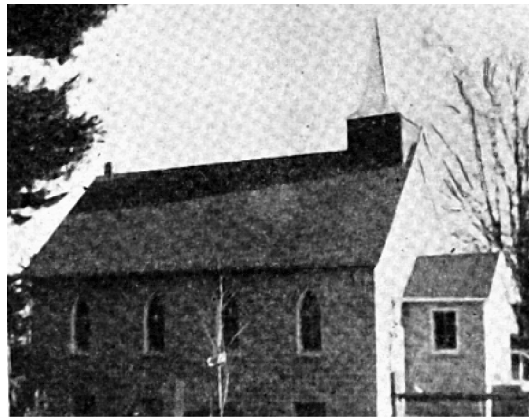
Dedication Church Supper
