HISTORY

THE FUND WAS INITIATED IN FEBRUARY 1980 AND IS REPRESENTED BY 37 VOLUNTEERS AND 38 HONOURARY MEMBERS. THE MAYOR AND WARDEN BEING HONOURARY CHAIRMEN. MEMBERS OF THE FUND RECEIVE NO REMUNERATION OF ANY KIND AND THERE IS NO PAID ADMINISTRATION. RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE IN PLACE. WE ARE MEMBERS OF THE CITY EMERGENCY CONTROL GROUP AND FULLY SUPPORTED, IN PRINCIPLE, BY THE FIRE AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS. WE HAVE BEEN GRATEFUL FOR PUBLIC SUPPORT OF OUR FUND.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

TO PROVIDE IMMEDIATE ASSISTANCE TO PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN DISPLACED OR WHO HAVE INCURRED LOSS DUE TO FIRE, FLOOD, EXPLOSION OR SOME OTHER TYPE OF DISASTER.

ASSISTANCE PROVIDED

1. Moral support to victims — needs and offers to help.
2. Immediate arrangements for suitable accommodation on a temporary basis, i.e. hotel or motel.
3. Immediate financial assistance to replace food and clothing.
4. Family emergency kit provided — combs, toothbrushes, soap, etc.
5. Smoke detector supplied, if needed.
6. Referrals to other social agencies for clothing, furnishings, etc.

We are **not** an INSURANCE COMPANY or WELFARE AGENCY.

GENERAL RULES

- a. A total of 5 signing Officers, all members of the Trust Fund committee.
- b. Representatives will provide advice and counselling if requested.
- c. Proper records of all transactions including payments to persons, hotel or motel accommodations, expenses and receipts for donations.
- d. The Treasurer will prepare a monthly financial statement. Fund will be audited.
- e. A Board of Trustees will ensure proper investments of Funds.
- f. Officers of the Fund will be elected at the annual meeting in February of each year.
