

E. S. Lot 1. Con. 3. Huron. - Feb. 1864. Donald Beaton from the Crown.

Jan. 12 - 1877 - Donald Beaton to Jacob Hodgkinson.

On death of Jacob Hodgkinson to Sarah, his wife.

Apr. 1901. - Sarah Hodgkinson to Ezekiel Hodgskin.

Oct. 1920. - Ezekiel Hodgkinson to Biddelia Hodgkinson, undivided half interest.

Oct. 1940. - Biddelia Hodgkinson to Henry Hodgkinson.

Apr. 1944. - Henry Hodgkinson to Don. J. Mac Iver.

On death of Don. J. Mac Iver on Nov. 1 - 1951, this property went to his wife Grace Mac Iver. Mar. 1952 sold by Grace Mac Iver to Richard Austin Martin.

Lot 1. Con. 3 Kinloss. - About 1854. Alexander Mac Donald and his wife, natives of the Isle of Skye, Scotland received a grant from the Crown for this 100 acres. In 1870 Alexander Mac Donald ~~received~~ Lot 1. Con. 3 to Jacob Hodgkinson, who raised a family of nineteen sons and two daughters on this property. In 1892 Alexander Mac Donald's son, - Angus bought this lot from Jacob Hodgkinson. When Angus Mac Donald died in 1930, his son John A. inherited the 100 ac. - W. S. of Lot 2. and E. S. of Lot 1, where he resided till his death in May 1953. Wm. J. Mac Donald inherited the W. S. of Lot 1 on his father's death in 1930 and on John A.'s death in 1953 he inherited the 100 acres. In Mar. 1954 he sold the 50 ac. - W. S. of Lot 2 to a Dutch immigrant, Jell De Jong. He and his wife and five children reside on this property.

E. S. Lot 2. and W. S. of Lot 3. Kinloss. - This property was taken up from the Crown by Jas. Martin, a native of the Isle of Skye, Scotland about 1854. Mr. Martin was married three times. His first wife was a Miss Paslon from Kinlough. She died when quite young and he married Euphemia Mac Donald who died in 1896. They had three daughters and a number of grandchildren, who spent considerable time with their grandparents. Late in 1897 he married Mary Mac Donald. Early in 1900 he sold the farm to Mr. Geo. Middleton, - who with his wife and four younger children moved to this farm early in 1902. Mr. & Mrs. Martin moved to Lucknow, where he died Jan. 26 - 1906. Mrs. Martin returned to her old home, Lot 3, Con. 4 in 1908. She died in 1945. Mr. Geo. Middleton was a retired school teacher, having been the first Principal of Lucknow Public School. Mrs. Middleton died in 1911 and Mr. Middleton in 1932 at the age of 94 yrs. Their son Russel acquired the farm in 1912. He and his wife Ruth Mac Ball had two sons. She died in Dec. 1950 and Russel Middleton still resides here.
