



The Centennial Royal Portraits

These new portraits, taken at Buckingham Palace for Canada's Centennial, show Queen Elizabeth wearing white satin gown. The bodice is decorated with pearls and crystals which radiate down the full skirt. She wears the Order of the Garter with diamond Garter star as well as two Family Order miniatures of King George V and King George VI. Prince Philip, in full-dress uniform of an Admiral of the Fleet, is wearing the sash and star of the Order of the Garter and the star of the Order of the Thistle.
