- 1880 - James Falconer, Charles Falconer (Scotsman from Ailsa Craig)
- 1900 - David Falconer, James Falconer
- 1920 - David Falconer

Mr. & Mrs. James Falconer had three children, Dave, Annie and Tom. All remained single till Dave married, a Mrs. Hume, in later years. Tom moved west where he farmed a sizable tract of land. He came home each winter and was a jolly fellow with lots of stories.

For seven years during the 1920's the farm was owned by Mr. & Mrs. Donald Low, a Scottish couple. They came as bride and groom and really became popular in the community. They had a sale in 1929 and moved to Detroit. He died in 1968.

David Falconer again took over the farm. In 1931 Mr. & Mrs. Wilson Wall rented the farm and in partnership with their son Gordon purchased it in 1944. Gordon became full owner in 1951.
