This 100 acres taken up from the Crown in 1853 by Jas. Fletcher. The East Half was sold to Jas. McLeod, then to John Good and later again to John MacMillan. On his death his son Ross acquired this property. The old house was taken down and the orchard has been removed for some time. This orchard was famed for its delicious pear tree. The barn was sold to Wm. Kempton on 86 Hwy. In 1967 Ross MacMillan sold this farm to Lorne Eadie.
