Since Lorne Eadie bought the farm in 1967 the house has been occupied by the Symes Family. The barn has been remodeled to suit the feeding of beef cattle. A new silo 90'/24', with silo unloader, has been built. The barn yard area filled with gravel etc. and cemented, then a high rail fence built around it. Cattle are never out on pasture. The old orchard, on corner, was bull-dozed out also all fences. Now fields can be ploughed full length of farm. Corn is grown. This year, 1970, Lorne has a beautiful field of fall wheat on the west half.
