

Lot 3, Concession 5, Kinloss

Taken up from the Crown by Nichol MacLean in 1853

West Half- Sold to James Harbourne in the 70's. Sold by him to Peter MacKinnon, at his death in 19 , it became the property of his sisters Mary and Margaret. Margaret predeceased Mary and on Mary's death it was acquired by her nephew, Archie MacKinnon. He sold it to Sam Chadwick in 1952.

Sold to Fraser MacKinnon

East Half-Sold in the 1880's to John Hedley who sold it to Angus Ross in the 1890's. He sold it to Bert Lovett who died in 19 . Then Harvey Mole owned it for a number of years, and he sold it in 19 to Richard MacQuillan Sr. He sold it to John Wolfe and his son Laverne. John Wolfe died in 1954 and his son continues to reside here.
