FURNISHINGS: Three extension tables, a side-board, rocking chair and a refrigerator were all donated. Folding and stacking chairs were purchased. For extra we purchased planks and butter boxes to set them on at a cost of \$2.00. A second-hand electric stove cost \$35.00 with hook-up and installation costing \$25.00. In 1962 we purchased a child's crib and a daybed for \$10.00, 4 card tables costing \$28. The school bell was sold for \$50.00, teachers desk for \$10.00 and the woodshed sold for \$20.00.

MONEY-RAISING PROJECTS: For many years we had a Calico Ball in the spring of the year and a St. Andrew's Ball in the Fall. Later these were discontinued with the changing interest of the public. We now make quilts and do quilting for others. A 1967 "Centennial Rose" quilt was made, tickets sold and we realized a profit of \$375.00. We do some catering to weddings for W.I. member families or for our 4-H girls if asked to do so. In the last year or two we have been catering to the Lion's Club suppers, about three times a year. For a number of years we have run the lunch booth and catered a supper at the Lucknow Craft Festival. We will also run a lunch booth at an auction sale in the community if asked to do so.
