From 1957 and for ten years following Kairshea W.I. gave a \$50.00 scholarship to the girl who was highest in the Home Economics class in the Lucknow & District High School. When the high school was moved to Wingham, and the W.I. was involved in a very tight money policy, it was decided to discontinue the scholarship.

In 1961-62 a Flag was purchased and presented to the new Kinloss Central School in Holyrood, for \$12.00.

1966-72 we purchased a trophy for the Senior Boy Champion at the Kinloss Central School for their Field Day.

The W.I. have made donations toward the project of equipping Beauty Salons in the two Bruce County homes for the Aged--Brucelea Haven in Walkerton and Gateway Haven in Wiarton. Donations over the years to Bruce County Museum; Bruce County Tartan and expenses for the 4-H clubs and their leaders which we have sponsored for many years.
