The Lucknow WI was organized in Feb 1908 by Miss Laura Rose. They met at the home of Mrs Thomas Reid. Mrs Garnet Armstrong was chosen Pres & Miss Fern Reid was Sec.

At the end of the first world war (no exact date can be found) The WI sponsored the erection of the war memorial at the cost of two thousand dollars, and later placed the spot lights in front of the Cenotaph and for a number of years paid for the lighting.

In 1948 the street signs were the project of the Board. In June 1961 was their first meeting in the newly decorated hall. They furnished the kitchen with an electric stove, Fridge, cooking utensils, dishes & silverware.

In 1973 we paid for the new fence around the Lucknow swimming pool.

In 1982 we gave the Lucknow District Fire Dept the money to pay for Portable Radio & Payper systems to be used for their protection. Over the years there has been 3 Lucknow Drs pictures enlarged & framed and given to the Lucknow Medical Center in memory of Dr Johnston, Dr Mckim & Dr Corbin.

This is just a few of the things done by the Lucknow WI. We are celebrating our 90th anniversary this year.
