The Lucknow WI was organized in Feb 1908 by Miss Laura Rose. They met ~~at~~ the home of Mrs Thomas Reid, Mrs Harriet Armstrong was chosen Pres. and Miss Fern Reid Sec.

At the end of the first world war. (no exact date can be found) The WI sponsored the erection of the war memorial at the cost of Two thousand dollars and later placed the spotlights in front of the tomb and for a number of years paid for the lighting.

In 1948 the street signs were the project of the branch.

In June 1961 was their first meeting in the newly decorated hall. They furnished the kitchen with an electric stove Frig. cooking utensils dishes + silverware

In 1973 we paid for the fence around the Lucknow swimming pool.

In 1972 we gave the Lucknow District Fire Dept. the money to pay for portable radio and pager systems to be used for their protection. Over the years there has been 3 pictures enlarged & framed and given to the Lucknow Medical Center namely Dr Johnston Dr McKim & Dr Coir.
