1901, May 30 Robert Given is building a new home; it will be covered with brick. (It is veneer.)

1917 Dec. 5 Robert Given has just finished cementing his stable and has it all fitted with iron stanchions, also a water system installed. He and his son did the work themselves.

1927, Sept. 1 A new bridge is to be constructed at the creek just south of the The foreman, D. Hellyer, expects to begin Monday.

Oct. 11 Mrs. J. D. White purchased a delco lighting plant recently installed by Mr. McNeil 1928 electrician from Paisley.

1914 10.14 -Mr. Jenson of Mar, was up at Miller Lake and bought Charlie Sadler's yearlings, paying \$50.00 a piece for five. We well remember the time when \$50.00 would about buy the whole five head.

1914 12.16 -Crane and Trout received 1000 turkeys this week from the North which is a pretty large purchase. These are being shipped to an American point for sale.

1915, Sept. 1 S. Crane, one of Mar's old boys, but now a barrister-at-law in Spokane, Washington, is visiting the scenes of his youth.

1959 7.2 -R. Gene McDonald, son of Mr. and Mrs. Wilfred D. McDonald of Ow. Sound, formerly of Wlarton, graduated from the School of Medicine in the recent Convocation of the University of Western Ontario, London, with the degree of Doctor of Medicine. He obtained Second Class Honors.
