Lot 43 Con.1

Bassie Kiratine had bought lot 43 con 1 S.D.R. in 1912. It contained about two and a half acres. In about the year 1926 and 1927 he decided to reforest this piece of land. It was nothing but weeds, such a wildcarrot, goldenrod, and some wild raspberry bushes. His three sons, Burns, Lloyd and Mac, helped with the planting of different kinds of pine trees. These trees are now 50 or 60 ft. tall and some are 1 1/2 ft. in diameter. At the present time Mac and his son Neil have been thinning out trashy trees and old dead elms.

West End
