

Lot 41 Concession 2 SDR

This farm is often still called the Traynor Farm.

In 1853 Thomas Traynor took the land from the crown

1900 Hugh Traynor took possession.

When Hugh Traynor died in 1950, Viola, Hugh's daughter sold the farm to John D. Aitken in 1952.

In 1954 Peter Zettler traded his Lot 47 Concession 3 SDR with John Aitken to get Lot 41 Concession 2 SDR. This farm was closer to the home farm.

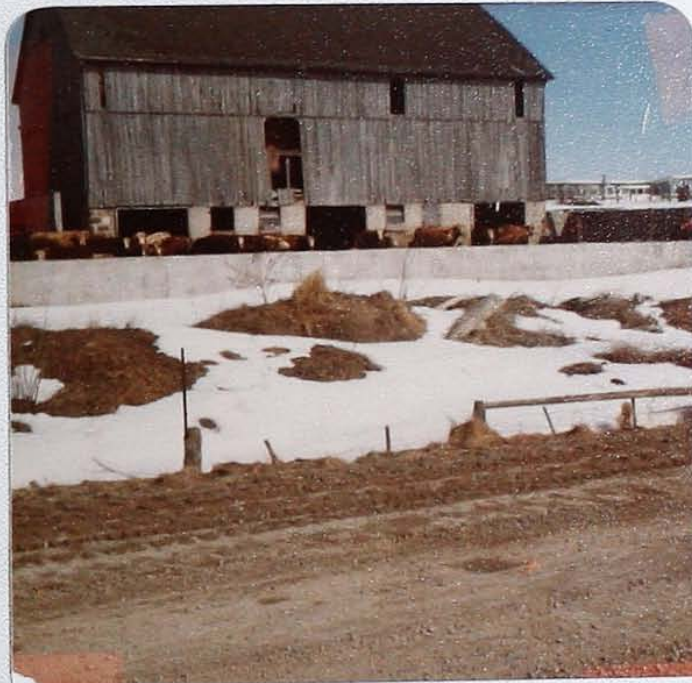
In 1958 it was sold to Hendrick and Jaantic Denbok. They never moved into the house.

In 1958 later in the year Wilmer Lerch purchased the farm..

In 1961 Peter Zettler once again purchased the land and the barn and the house was severed.

In 1970 Francis (son of Peter Zettler) and Eugenia Zettler purchased the land and barn.

In 1974 a pit silo was added and constructed cement barnyard walls and cemented the barnyard floor. The barn has been primarily used for feeding beef cattle.
