Crispin's Hanover Cemetery

About a mile south of Hanover on Lot 74, Con. 2 SDR, is one of the early cemeteries of the area. The first cemetery for Hanover was considered too far east so the citizens got together, put up money and approached Mr. John Crispin for land.

Mr. Crispin did not want to sell but finally was persuaded to give up forty acres at forty dollars an acre. It seems this

transaction was arranged in 1868.

At first it was thought that the acreage purchased was far too large but before many years had passed, more land was needed and it was acquired across the road in Grey County.
