

We, the undersigned,
 Members of the South-Rive Women's Institute
 and all other residents of the South-Rive of
 Brant, and surrounding areas, have
 grave concern about the safety of the bridge
 on the West-end of the South Rive.

Whereas there is a great deal of traffic over
 this bridge, not only from South-Rive
 residents, but also from the surrounding
 areas, and,

Whereas the school buses are ordered not to use
 this bridge any longer, and,

Whereas modern farm machinery is too large
 to pass over this out dated bridge, and,

Whereas neither milk trucks nor any other
 bulk carriers can use the bridge, and,
 whereas in case of emergency as of fire, or
 sudden illness or accident, valuable
 time would be lost to reach the scene,

and,
 whereas precious lives could be lost for lack
 of a safe bridge, and,

whereas residents of surrounding townships
 also use this bridge, and,

whereas time and money is lost by the farmers
 on the South-Rive due to this unsafe bridge, and

whereas the sign placed on the bridge proclaims
 a load limit of 5 tonnes which obviously
 shows the danger of using this bridge,

be it therefore resolved, that we, the undersigned,
 strongly urge the Council of the Township of
 Brant to make every effort to try and remedy
 this serious and dangerous situation.

All these conditions also apply to the bridge
 on the East-end of the South-Rive which
 at the present is closed.
