

Traynor Bridge open — official ribbon cutting



OPENING OF BRIDGE

WALKERTON — MP for Bruce Grey Gary Gurbin and several other local politicians officially opened a new \$352,000.00 bridge near here Friday evening. This is the fifth replacement for this section of the road.

The township began working on a bridge reconstruction program 10 years ago with financing coming through local township and the Ministry of Transportation and Communications funding. The original bridge was built in 1855 by the Traynor family, original settlers in the area.
