

This farm comprising of 100 acres, was purchased from the Crown by John Cameron, for \$200.00 on May 10th, 1869.

At Mr. Cameron's death in 1876, the Executors of the estate sold it to William Smith. His wife was Annie Brooks. This union was blessed by four children, namely, Maude (Mrs. Hampshire, deceased), Ethel, (Mrs. George Gilchrist), Essie (Mrs. George, deceased), and Bert, who lives in Alberta.

Mr. Smith erected the present buildings.

In 1903, Mr. Smith sold the farm to Robert Brown, and his wife was Susan Leask. They had no heirs.

Mr. Brown sold the farm in 1918 to Mr. Alex. J. Lamont. He was married to Katherine McDonald. They had one son, Alastair.

On March 6th, 1935, Alex. MacDougall of Bruce Township bought this farm, and is the present owner of it.

He was married to Ella Kaake, (daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charlie Kaake, of Bruce Township), in July 1938. They have one daughter, Jane, at present on the teaching staff in the City of Brantford.

In 1939 hydro was installed in the house, and in 1945, in the barn. A pressure system was added in the year 1950.
