Lot 26, Concession 1, Saugeen.

William Forrester and his wife, Annie McKellar came from Stirlingshire, Scotland, and settled at Lot 26, Concession 1, Saugeen Township.

They cleared land, and built a house and a barn. Here four of their eleven children were born: Jane, Mrs. Adam Cairns; John, Thomas and Edward.

About 1870 he sold this farm to his brother-in-law, James Munro, and moved to Lot 21, Concession 5, Saugeen, which he farmed until he retired to Port Elgin in 1906.

At Mr. Munro's death, the farm, Lot 26, passed to his son, John S. Munro, who sold the same to Peter H. Stafford.

In 1954, Mr. Stafford sold the farm to Robert Harvey Thomas, the present owner.
