McEwing, in the composition of the words and music for an appropriate Institute song. Mrs. McEwing brought honor to our Branch and District by winning 3rd prize in the Province of Ontario. This song was sung by a group of our ladies at the District Annual meeting at Mount Hope, the Bruce County Rally at Lucknow, and the first Grey-Bruce Area Convention, held in Owen Sound.

"In the Tweedsmuir Competitions for 1961, we decided to enter this Tweedsmuir Book, under the convenorship of Mrs. Moffatt Jamieson, Mrs. J. McEwing and Mrs. Grant Clazie.

"In the Fall of 1958, we journeyed in a group to Wingham, under the convenorship of Mrs. M. Black, Mrs. J. Reoch and Mrs. J. Cluley, and after dining at the Brunswick Hotel, visited the C.K.N.X. Radio and Television Station.
