"Needlecraft"

This project, lead by Mrs. John Sutherland and Mrs. Jas. Bell, was designed to introduce the girls to (1) the fun of embroidery as a decorative touch and a means of creative expression, (2) the development of colour appreciation and its use and (3) knowledge of the elements of good design.

Five girls, Kathy Howe, Sharon Bell, Colleen Howe, Joan Schildroth and Laurel McKinnon completed the project. They were required to learn 7 basic embroidery stitches--blanket, feather, lazy daisy, chain, fly, roman, crewel and to use them in a set design on a "Learning Stitches Article". A "Free Choice Article" gave the girls the opportunity to express themselves creatively in colour and design.

Eight regular meetings were required to complete the project and at an extra, social supper meeting, the leaders entertained the members and the girls wrote their skit.

Miss Anne Patrick, Home Economist for Bruce County, was in charge of Achievement Day, Dec. 6th. The South Saugeen Girls presented their skit "Colour Schemes in Embroidery".

The 4-H Homemaking Club Project "The Third Meal" was the spring Club for 1969.
