Board of Trustees

As stated above, the Board of Trustees consisted of three men, with the chairman and secretary chosen from their number. This system continued for many years, then a fourth member was added to act as secretary-treasurer. In 1946 the Saugeen Township School Afea was formed, which embraced the seven school sections of Saugeen. A public meeting of rate-payers was held and a new board of five members was nominated. This first area board consisted of Gordon Cann, George Chappell, James Christie, Iden Leeder and Clarence Dawson.

Kenneth Gowanlock was appointed secretary-treasurer at a salary of \$200., a position he held until Jan. 1967 when a joint board was formed with the Port Elgin Public School Board. This Board consists of two representatives from Saugeen and three from Port

Elgin. Saugeen's representatives on this Board are Charles Kelly and Kent Lamont.

Inspectors

For the first 60 years of school history, only three inspectors' names are recorded: Mr. Campbell, Mr. Chisholm and Mr. W. R. Bald, who held the position for 24 years. He was followed by G. C. Dobson in 1935.

Many present today will remember with affection later inspectors, including Mr. J. M. Game, Mr. A. A. Gilroy, Mr. E. Clyde Evans, Mr. W. S. Hougham, Mr. D. W. Simpson, and our present inspector Mr. W. S. McInnis.

Graduates

Many graduates of this school settled in the community and have proven themselves to be hard-working and prosperous farmers. Others left to seek their fortune in distant places, and we are indeed proud of their successes.

In wartime, too, the graduates of this school have heeded the call of their country to serve with the Army, Navy and Airforce. We recall with sadness those who paid the supreme sacrifice.

Improvements

The trustees have always shown wisdom and foresight in maintaining and improving the school. From the secretary's minute book we read of hydro being installed in the school in November 1939. In May 1946 a piano was purchased and in January 1948 a radio was bought with the proceeds of the Christmas concert.
