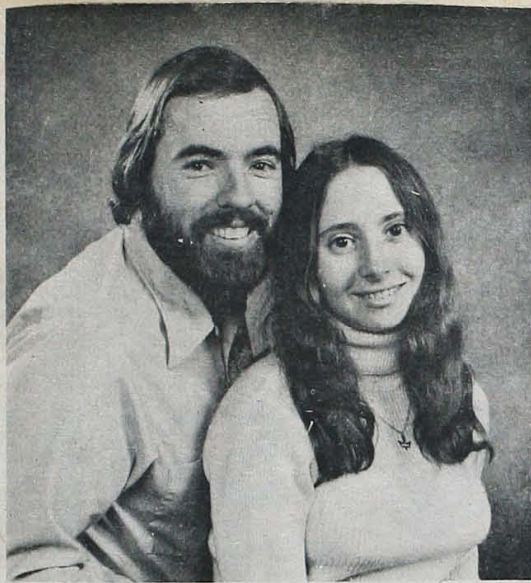


# Weddings
