She returned to nursing at Saugeen Memorial Hospital in Southampton in 1973. Despite the personal loss of their son, Richard, having to deal with serious health problems, and the strain of farm life, she remained a source of strength that the rest of her family could draw from. Mrs. Lamont always made time for community service. She was instrumental in establishing the Bluewater School for the mentally retarded. She served as a worker and a leader for the Port Elgin Minor Hockey Association, the South Saugeen Women's Institute, 4-H Homemaking clubs, Tolmie Memorial Presbyterian Church, C.B.I.T., Port Elgin Fair Board, and the Canadian Cancer Society.
