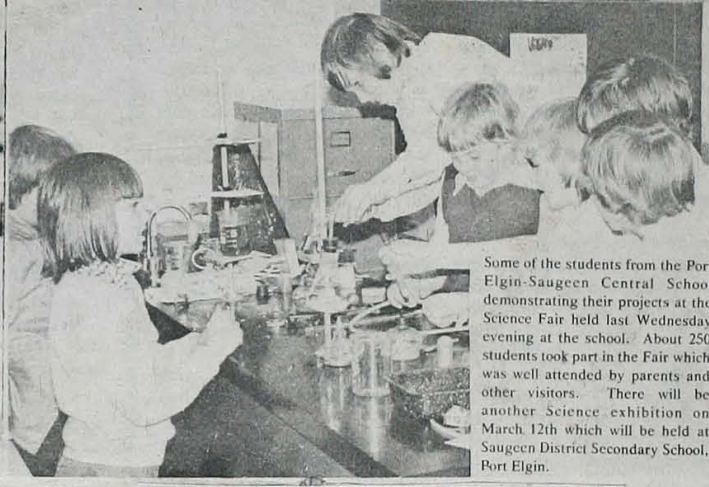


Science Fair at Port Elgin Saugeen Central School
