We are glad to report a good crowd attended the Benefit Dance for Mr. and Mrs. Fred Collard, who recently suffered a barn fire.

Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Maas have returned home from their trip to Hawaii where they enjoyed a week or two of lovely warm temperatures. The trip was partly sponsored by Psyzer Seed & Grain Co. He was one of the salesmen with the highest sales turnover for Trojan corn.

Fire completely destroyed the large barn of Fred Collard on the 4th Concession of Saugeen Township early Saturday morning.

In addition to the barn a milking parlour was lost, along with approximately 7,000 bales of hay and 600 bales of straw.

A neighbour, Tim McArthur turned in the alarm. Firefighters from Saugeen Township were at the scene, and were able to contain the blaze so that the nearby house and implement shed were not destroyed.

Mr. Collard managed to rescue 75 dairy cows, but a number of small cattle were lost.

Damage is estimated to be in the neighbourhood of \$100,000., and is partially covered by insurance.

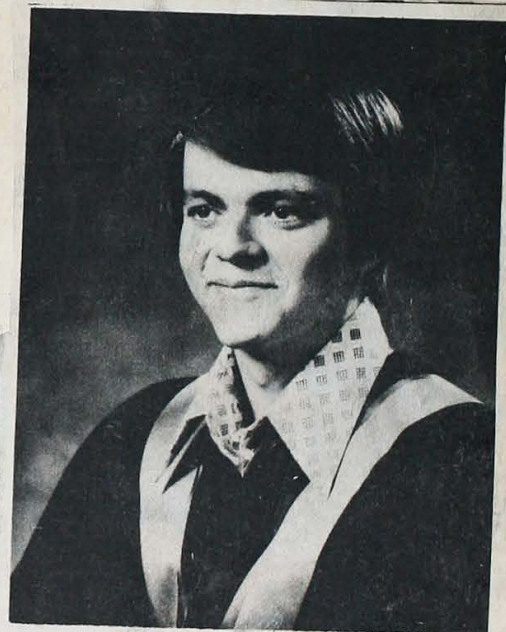
GERALD ROSS LAMONT
