Local air cadets take silver medal finish

Twelve local Air and Sea Cadets travelled to CFB Petawawa on the weekend to compete in the two day Ontario Region Biathlon Competitions. Two weeks earlier these cadets earned the right to represent the western Ontario Area by their finishes at the area competitions in Cedar Springs

Petawawa was hit with rain and freezing rain which made for poor skiing conditions for the 11 teams competing on Saturday. In a the three person team competitions each cadet skies a total of five kilometers stopping at the range twice. At the range stops the cadet has Peight chances to shoot down five 115 mm tardigets at a distance of 50 meters. Penalty loops dare skied for each missed target.

The male and female teams representing he Western Ontario Area were both from the Port Elgin 340 Air Cadet Squadron. Phil lobinson, Barry McLaughlin and Chris uckton received a silver medal for their secnd place finish in the male division. Tara goisin, Vicki Robinson and Alison Mather ried and shot to a fourth place finish in the emale division.

Temperatures dropped late Saturday and only came up to -14 degrees C. by race time on Sunday making for icy conditions on the rails for the 50 cadets competing in individval competitions. In the individuals each
