The first step for the provincial Liberal party is to rebuild from the bottom up and re-establish what it is the Liberal party stands for.


Lamont, 39, has lived all his life in this area. He was raised in Saugeen Township and was away for only the four years he was in university.

Afterward, he became area co-ordinator for five ridings and managed campaigns for Murray Elston in 1990 and Bruce Lauckner this year.

There were 1,200 delegates at the annual meeting on the weekend. Of the 13 positions available, 10 were contested by a total of 25 candidates.
