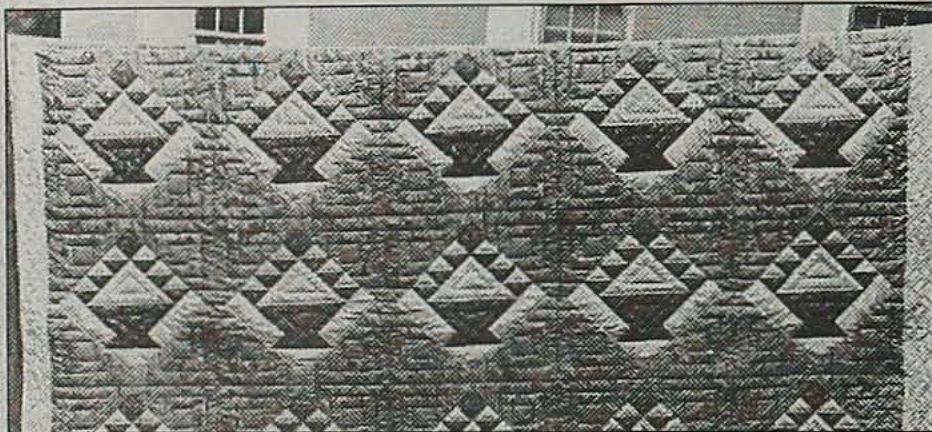


Needlework supports nursing home
