EIGHT YEAR OLD GLENN LAVALLEE holds the 49 inch, 31-3/4 pound muskie which he hooked in the Ottawa River in the Goodwin's Bay area last Monday evening. The grade four student at McNab Public School, beside which he lives, caught the fish with a 12 pound test line and a new red and white wobbler which he is holding.

Fishing with his father, Ken Lavallee, and Lou Bigras he had only 35 or 40 feet of line out. His father helped him as it took 45 minutes to land the fish. They landed the muskie at Ben Frieday's cottage where several men also helped to bring the catch up on shore.
