Local man dies after hit by bull

ST. BERNARDIN — A 2-year-old holstein bull inflicted injuries which eventually led to the death of a local dairy farmer.

Rejean Levac, 57, suffered serious injuries late the afternoon of Sept. 5 when he was collecting his herd to return to the stable and the bull hit him, said family member and neighbour Gaston Levac. Rejean Levac was hospitalized immediately and died of complications three days later, Sept. 8, in an Ottawa facility.

The community gathered for funeral services in Fournier Sept. 11 to mourn the death of the local farmer.

Prescott agriculture representative André Pommerville expressed sympathy for the well-known St. Bernardin dairy family. He said the potential dangers of bulls should never be underestimated. "We recommend bulls over six months old be restrained."

Accident kills Fournier man
