The above pictures, all taken about the same time, and over sixty years ago, appeared in The Walkerton Souvenir Book of 1921, published for the town's fiftieth anniversary of incorporation celebrations, showing a three-generation photo grouping, representing the Wesley family's role in the newspaper publishing business of the Bruce County Town. The grandson was six years old at the time.

The late William Wesley, a veteran newspaperman, was publisher of The Bruce Herald, in Walkerton, dating back to 1883.

The late Arthur Wesley, noted local publisher and editor since 1905, died in 1945. The present publisher and editor of The Walkerton Herald-Times, Harold Wesley, purchased the business from the Wesley estate in 1953, after having been associated with same for the previous exactly twenty years.
