

Our motto for the day was "Our Heritage - a precious past,
our responsibility our future." Our roll call was "Building that
has vanished in the community."

At the February meeting, which was Educational, I gave a
historical account of the schools in Harean. The first school was
built in a little building in the Hall yard, then in a little larger building
across the road. In 1820 a parcel of land was bought for the
sum of five shillings. A stone school was erected here. Then in
1929 a three room school with wash rooms was erected and the old
one was abandoned. It is now an off grading station.

Now in the year 1961 a five room school has been finished
with 154 pupils in grades 4-7 attending.

In 1860 the teacher J. B. White received a salary of less than \$100.
as principal, with an assistant receiving \$30. - March 1st of 1961 the
principal received \$2700 with the other teacher \$1500.

This is my last year as historical branch chairman and it
is one I give up with regret. I have enjoyed exploring you back into
the past and I hope that my successor finds it as interesting.
