For the purpose of your records, we may advise that we have registered in the name of Alma Majaury, Berna Barrie, Ruth Raycroft and Myrtle McNab as Trustees for White Lake Women's Institute, the following conveyances:

1. Deed - John S. Box, Harry M. Box, Alexander S. Brown, Robert John Brown, Margaret Frances Brown joining therein to bar her dower, covering Lot 22 on the north-east side of Main Street in the Village of White Lake on the 29th day of June, 1964 as No. 69855.
2. Deed - The Trustee Board of the Presbyterian Church in Canada covering Lots Nos. 22, 23 and 24 on the south-west side of Allan Street in the Village of White Lake on the 2nd day of July, 1964 as No. 69932.

We have reported directly to the White Lake Women's Institute and are enclosing herewith our statement of account in connection with the transfer from the Presbyterian Church which we trust you will find satisfactory. We have forwarded our account to the Presbyterian Church covering the deeds, the Discharge of the previously existing Mortgage, the registrations of Succession Duty Certificates in the Estates of Violet Brown and Francis W.
