In 1830 a group of Settlers Arrived from the Campbell Distric This group included the m<sup>rs</sup> Nabbs, m<sup>rs</sup> Kaye, m<sup>rs</sup> Nevins, @ Camerons and @ Campbells.

In 1834 a large party of Stewarts, m<sup>rs</sup> Lachlans Robitsons, Ferguson's and Duffs, arrived from Blair, Athol, Scotland,

Besides the chiefs dwelling on the Chats Lake He erected a beautiful residence, at White Lake. There were two stories in this residence, and a lovely big basement full size of house.

In the bottom storey there were four rooms, and in one of those rooms facing the ~~White~~ Lake was a stone fireplace.

This dwelling was built in a ~~strong~~ strategic position, facing what is called the narrows, ~~in the white lake~~ ~~in daylight~~ which led from the white lake into the Bay in which stood a boat-club.
