Thomas Baty helped organize Hope Sunday School on the first concession and the family has a cane that was presented to him in 1888 in appreciation of his help.

The family was musical and most of them were members of the choir. Of this family, Thomas Baty, Robert T and Lloyd have been choir leaders and Marie and Velma, organists.

Violet Baty served on the Mission Field in China for a number of years. There she met and married Norman Knight. On their return to Canada he served as pastor of the United Church at Blackie, Alberta. The farm has been broken so that only a part of the original acreage remains in the Baty family. The Buchanan Hydro Station was built on the property and Highway 401 took a strip across the farm south of the buildings. The large white brick house and frame barn still stand. As of 1964, Lloyd Baty is on the farm and his cousin, Robert W. living on the farm near the pond.
