THE ORIGINAL WILTON GROVE PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILT AROUND 1852 WAS LOCATED AT EXETER AND WELLINGTON ROADS AND WAS CLOSED IN 1954. A NEW WILTON GROVE PUBLIC SCHOOL WAS CONSTRUCTED FURTHER TO THE EAST ON EXETER ROAD AND SUBSEQUENTLY BECAME THE FOREST CITY SCHOOL. THIS SCHOOL COMMEMORATES THE NAME WILTON GROVE BY WHICH THIS AREA OF THE CITY WAS FORMERLY KNOWN AND THE NAME OF THE TWO FORMER SCHOOLS.
