

Shouldice on side for next year

Sponsor will add more money

SAUBLE BEACH — Shouldice Designer Stone of Shallow Lake has confirmed it will continue as the title sponsor of the ALSTAR Late Model Super Series.

The company committed \$40,000 to the series points fund this year and that figure will increase in 2006, though it's not clear yet by how much.

"The marketing package we put together is acceptable, they like the ideas, they're excited about it," series owner/promoter Joe Chisholm said at the series awards banquet Sunday at Sauble Speedway.

"They're going to increase the points fund and I'm telling you, it's going to make a lot of racers excited. That makes for good racing and I know the race fans are going to be in for a treat in 2006."

"It's a very good venue for the company and for our customers," said Shouldice director of sales and marketing Bob Sanders. "It's a good venue for advertising, just to get more exposure for Shouldice in the Ontario market."

He said the company realizes that the sport of racing doesn't just need sponsors with lots of money, it also needs sponsors who will be around for a while.

"Stability is what they're after, and that's what our company is about," Sanders said. "When we invest in something, we're there for the long term to make sure we all get a good return on the investment."

The Shouldice family has a long connection with Sauble Speedway, dating back to when Rob Shouldice, current president of the family-owned company, was a driver there.

"The great thing about our company is we're all actively involved," Sanders said. "We have a passion for it. It's not difficult for us to come out to see the Saturday night races."

Tentative plans for 2006 include 100-lap races, an electronic scoring system and the possibility that Discovery Channel Canada may produce and broadcast a documentary series about ALSTAR. **THE OWEN SOUND SEPTEMBER 6, 2005**
