he had fun this summer going to Santa's Village, as for going back to school Cam was less than enthusiastic, but said he enjoyed Gym and Math.

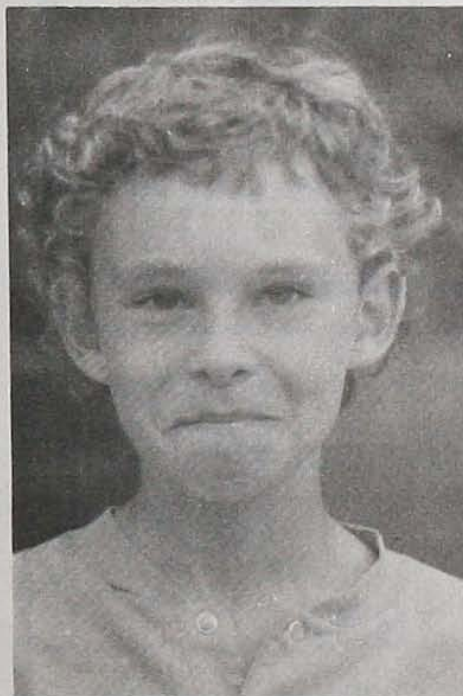
