



MEDICAL CENTRE AT HOSPITAL — Last Friday local residents and tourists in the Warton area were given the opportunity to tour the recently completed medical centre located in the lower floor of the south wing of the Warton and Dis-

trict Memorial Hospital. This wing was opened in June, 1968. Two doctors and a dentist are renting the ultra-modern facilities which were constructed at an estimated cost of \$36,000. Here is an exterior view of the south wing.
